- We have had a reduction of 19 racist offences, compared to this time last year. Terror attacks from last year happened around April-May 2017, so the reduction makes sense.
- Good reduction in Islamophobic hate crime over 12-week period.
- Alan says there has been a real improvement over the last few months.
- The data is available if requested.

# IV. Presentation on the new PREVENT strategy - Simon Smith, Prevent Programme Manager, Tower Hamlets Council

- PREVENT is about safeguarding vulnerable people and is part of the CONTEST strategy (the national counter-terrorism strategy)
- Made up of the four p's: prevent, pursue, protect and prepare.

#### What is PREVENT?

- To stop people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism
- Operates in the pre-criminal space
- Tower Hamlets is a tier 1 priority area for the government we are one of 9 tier boroughs in the country. This releases significant funding for preventative action and sharing good practice.

# Includes work on:

- Right wing extremism
- Real risk around the use of social media, one of the key methods that expose people (including young people) to these materials)
- They deal with individuals that have been assessed and have links to terrorism (or people at significant risk of being influenced by certain groups)

#### Key priorities for 2018/19

- Collaborative partnership working between the local authority and the local community - very keen on community involvement
- Increased inter-agency and partnership working, transparency and clear ownership of risk

- Increased youth outreach to get young people's support in shaping how this works
- Increased awareness of Prevent, local risks and sharing of good news/communications
